In honor of National Library Worker's Day, we took a delightful excursion to our local library and gave them a basket filled with a variety of treats and goodies for them to enjoy!

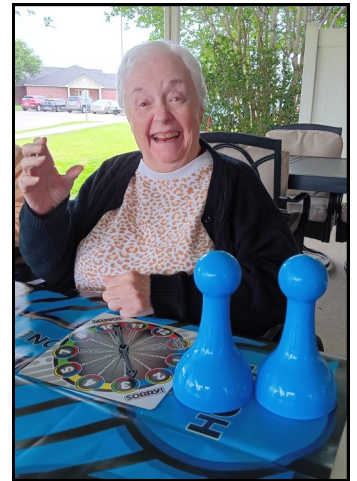
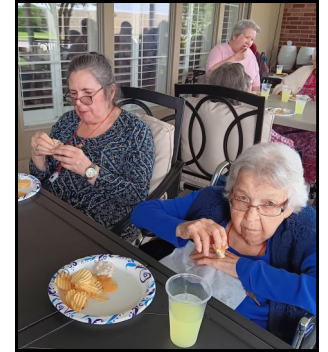
