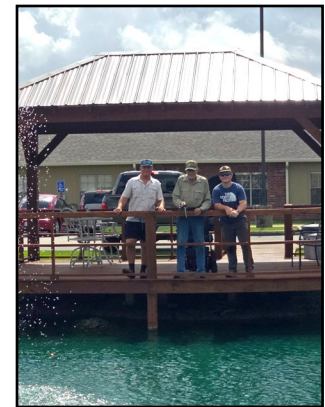

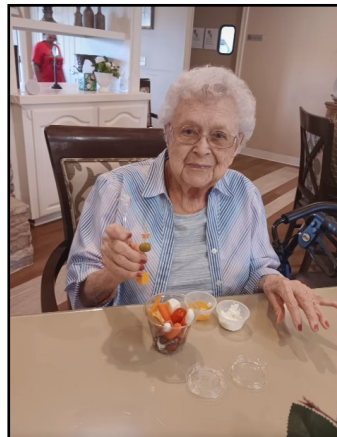
HOOKED ON FUN!
